

FALL 2020 COURSE FORMATS



Flexible Online. Students complete course work and may view recorded lectures on their own schedule. Assignments/assessments will have due dates. Live Zoom web-conferencing is optional and any Zoom sessions must be recorded and posted. Faculty may not require student participation in live interactions and the design of all interaction and assignments is based on the principle of asynchronous instruction and participation.

Scheduled Remote. Students meet regularly in an online classroom, via Zoom, at the times advertised in the class schedule. The nature of course interactions can vary, but must_include faculty facilitation in real-time (e.g. lectures, Q&A sessions, facilitated discussions). All Zoom lectures/interactions must be recorded. Faculty should follow division policy to address any assignments that the students may miss by being unable to join a lecture in real-time.





Hybrid: Students learn both online and, for some amount of face-to-face interaction, **on campus**. Chairs /coordinators will determine the minimum amount of time needed for students to spend on campus for each course. Syllabi and Canvas will be used to communicate dates and procedures for arriving on campus. The days/ times used must concur with those advertised in the schedule. The online portion may be scheduled or unscheduled and asynchronous.
